- **BLAZE ORANGE HAT IS REQUIRED FOR ALL SHOOTERS.** FAIR WEATHER HUNTERS BEWARE: NO RAINOUTS OR CANCELLATIONS. SNOW IS BETTER HUNTING. RAIN MEANS YOU SHOOT WET BIRDS. **HUNT (GROUPS OF FOUR) STARTS AT 8:00 A.M. SHARP. ARRIVE EARLY TO SIGN IN.**
- Guided hunts with well-trained dogs. Your trained dog is welcome, but you must make prior arrangements to bring your dog, and choose not to use their guide or dogs.
- A 25-round trap shoot is available for an additional \$5 per person (to be paid on site). Shells are available at the club at a reasonable price: **410, 28, 20, 16, 12 gauge shells / #6 SHOT MAXIMUM FOR HUNTING.**
- Lunch served after the hunt. Allow time for the pyramid shoot and the fabulous raffle at lunch. **YOU DO NOT NEED TO BE PRESENT TO WIN THE SPECIAL RAFFLE SHOTGUN!!**
- Bird cleaning in the cleaning facility (bring knife, cooler) or choose cleaned and frozen birds (for a price).
